

Hall of Fame Eligibility and Procedures

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Eligibility

To be eligible for the UMAPP Hall of Fame, a candidate shall have made significant contributions to the promotional products industry within our regional as outlined on the nomination form. *Past or current involvement in UMAPP at the administrative level (board or committee) is of primary importance.* The candidate may be living or deceased; retired, or active.

Current members of the UMAPP Board of Directors are not eligible. If a candidate has served on the Board, he or she must be off four years before being eligible as a Hall of Fame Nominee.

At the time of nomination, the nominator should not be in the same company as the candidate.

Procedure for Nomination and Election

All Association members are eligible to submit a nomination. Nominations shall be screened by the Board Officers. No more than half of the candidates may be posthumous nominations. Election to the Hall of Fame shall be by ballot vote of the Board of Directors.

Induction

Candidates accepted for the Hall of Fame recognition will be inducted at the Room Show luncheon or another appropriate venue as determined by the Board of Directors.
